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INTERNATIONAL COMMERCE HIGH SCHOOL IS RELOCATING

The mission of the International Commerce High School is to prepare adult high school students (16 years of age to 21 years of age) academically for occupational education, postsecondary education, social responsibility, employability, and lifelong learning.

The International Commerce High School has been helping adult high school students earn their high school diploma since 1997. **To better serve adult students, the International Commerce High School is relocating to 432 E Southern Ave: the northwest corner of Southern and 5th Street. New classes begin Monday, November 27, 2023.**

The school is proud to provide Valley Metro Local Bus and Light Rail passes to all enrolled students. The transition to the new campus will be easy for students that take the bus because the new campus is located along the same bus route the existing campus is located on (Route 7).

432 E Southern Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85040, is located:

- 0.3 miles from the Valley Metro Bus stop #10624 (Southern Avenue and 7th Street), Route 7
- 330 feet from the Valley Metro Bus stop #13931 (3rd Street and Southern Avenue eastbound), Route 61,
- 600 feet from the Valley Metro Bus stop #14101 (Southern Avenue and 6th Street westbound) and #14102 (Southern Avenue and 4th Street westbound), Route 61,
- 0.3 miles from the Valley Metro Bus stop #10058 (Central Avenue and Southern Avenue), Route 0A.

Additional student services include:

- Flexible attendance hours that support working students
- All courses meet Arizona high school graduation requirements
- Students may enroll and graduate any day of the week throughout the school year
- 24/7 access to all curriculum
- Remote access to instructors and learning support during non-school hours
- School is open from the end of July through the middle of June every year

American Heart Association Basic Life Support Certification

As a service to adult learners who pass the American Heart Association Basic Life Support certificate examinations, the International Commerce High School and Humanities and Sciences Academy Arizona pays for the American Heart Association Basic Life Support certificate through the American Heart Association. This certification increases student employability and is recognized by Community Colleges as a prerequisite for all healthcare career certificates and degrees.

ACT WorkKeys National Career Readiness Certificate

Adult learners take the ACT National Career Readiness Certificate course, a nationally recognized work skills credential. The ACT National Career Readiness Certificate (ACT NCRC®) is an assessment-based credential powered by ACT WorkKeys®. Issued at four levels, the ACT NCRC measures and certifies the essential work skills needed for success in jobs across industries and occupations. The ACT NCRC is widely used by employers, educators, workforce developers, and others with a stake in the success of the economy. More than 2.3 million ACT NCRCs have been issued nationwide since the credential was introduced in 2006.

ACT NCRC highlights: Awarded at four levels— Bronze, Silver, Gold, and Platinum; Research-based assessments; Measures and certifies broadly relevant foundational work skills; Recognized and recommended by thousands of employers; Gold and Platinum levels are recommended for college credit by the American Council on Education (ACE); Serves as the basis of state- and county-level workforce and economic development initiatives.

College Level Examination Program- CLEP

Over 2,900 colleges and universities grant credit for CLEP exams. By taking the CLEP exams, learners earn college credit for what they already know, saving both time and money towards earning a degree. Students may take CLEP examinations in: Composition and Literature; World Languages; History and Social Sciences; Science and Mathematics; and Business. Since 1998, students at the International Commerce High School and the Humanities and Sciences Academy Arizona have been very successful taking these tests. Their success has saved students time and money in their post-secondary education.

General Education Development Test

Since 1997, adult learners, eighteen (18) years or older, may take the General Education Development test once they have completed the Reading Foundations courses. Students demonstrating college readiness scores may qualify for (1) waiver from developmental education requirements and courses, and/or (2) waiver from placement testing. Students scoring at the College Ready + Credit Level enables them to earn a recommendation to receive college credits when they enroll in a participating postsecondary institution.
